1. Trade Access

- Key Safe / Intercom Coded
- Multiple people know the code
- Too Small
- No Log of who has the keys
- Easy to break into
- Change it every few months/1yr







- Codeless Key Safe
- Access Times 24/7 or specific
- Access via their mobile
- Traceable / Log
- Larger and Stronger Key Safe
- Remove Keys altogether
- Multiple Access Points (Entrance, Garage Door etc)



2. Resident Access

- Fobs / Remote Controls / Keys
- Lost fobs / Swipes / Remote controls
- Expensive
- Common Area Access
- Manager has to allow access via
 Security System per booking
- Time consuming
- System Upgrade costly and have to
 organise handover in some cases of
 new fobs/remotes

- Access Points Entrances / Exits /
 Lift / Garage Door / Common Areas
 Doors / Apartment Doors
- Common Areas Booking Times
- All automated
- Mobile to gain access
- Remote access
- Traceable / Log
 - Software Updates







3. Short Stays

- Physical keys/fobs/remotes
- External Key Safes
- Keys left in Letterboxes
- Key Safes at Shops
- Unsafe
- Handover Time Consuming
- 100% Digital via the Portal
- Grant access to some or all access points

- Grant access for time of booking
- Multiple people access
- Traceable / Log
- Short Stays gain access via an Email and SMS
- Integration with Airbnb/Bookings etc - all automated









Short Stays

SUMMARY

- Grant Guest/s Access for time of their booking
 E.g Check In: Friday 3pm Check Out: Sunday 11am
- Approve Access Points/Areas
 E.g Building Front Door / Garage Door / Lift / Apartment Front Door
- Multiple People
- Message and Email
- Only require a Mobile Phone
- Traceable / Log





RECAP

- Remove Coded External Key Safes / Intercom Codes
- Les Keys / Fobs / Remote Controls in the Key Safe
- Traceable / Log
- Managers have control of the Trades and when they can gain access
- Safer / Secure
- Less Fobs / Remotes in circulation in general
- Cost effective
- Less time consumed dealing with lost and new fobs/remotes
- Locksmiths can grant access onsite from their phone or from their office once a resident have been verified. No more Keys.
- Safer and easier to control the Short Stay guests without key/fob handover. All done via their Mobile Phone

THE C2A FEATURE CAN BE USED FOR:

- Key safes
- Front doors
- Apartment front doors
- Garage doors
- Rear entrance and exit doors
- Common areas doors that require booking to simplify access for both trades and residents.
 (E.g. Conference room, theatre room, kitchenette, tennis court, BBQ area, roof top area, sports bar)
